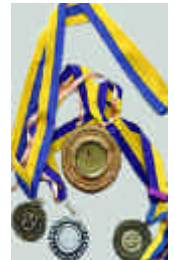
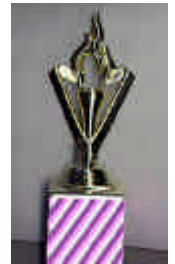

As Canada's top-ranked Youth DanceSport couple and one of Canada's most promising Dancesportcouples, Vadim and Nadiya need a yearly budget of USD50,000 - to make considerable progress on the world level and to keep coming closer to their dream of becoming the "World Champions". Your assistance to alleviate their burdens in any form, or sponsoring them is always welcome and deeply appreciated.

1. Training \$ 15,750

Average about 4 private lessons and 3 group seminars a week. Plus once every 2 months lessons with foreign international coaches.

2. Travel \$ 14,000

It includes air, train, bus and taxi fares, hotels and hostels, visas and other travel expenses.

3. Practice \$850

They need to pay for about 5 practice floor hours, almost every day in every country they go.

4. Shoes and Costumes \$ 6,400

Shoes \$200 each pair,
8 pairs altogether: \$800
4 dresses \$1100 each: \$4400
1 tail suit: \$600
mans Latin costumes: \$600



5. Hair dressing and supplies \$ 1,350

They use make up, hair dressing, tanning and similar supplies and services for each competition.



6. Entry fees \$ 2,750

Every competition charges either for entrance tickets or for registration directly. Sometimes it includes postage, courier, long distance and other expenses.

Total \$15,750 + \$14,000 + \$850 + \$6,400 + \$1,350 + \$ 2,700 = \$ 41,050
this is the amount they need to maintain their current level

We provide services to the sponsors covering part of the before mentioned expenses. You can advertise your organization, person or business using our public exposure. The prices are shown for a yearly term.

1. Official spoken word acknowledgements at every event - \$1000. Whenever they have an appropriate chance to acknowledge you in public either officially on the microphone or in semi-private interviews.

2. Exposure on printed materials and web sites - \$2000. We run 3 official web sites. Flyers are printed for every fundraiser. We spread about 2000 business cards a year.

3. Dressing emblems - \$5000. Your logo on their competition costumes according to CADA rules on size and color. Your text and emblem freely shown on their track suits and other secondary dressing elements, that they wear before and after the floor performance on the competition. We can also expose it freely at their performance costumes at non-competition events.
